In meeting HB 276 requirements, all bullying incidents are to be documented and publicized to the community. As written in the Madison Middle School Student Handbook, Bullying is defined as any intentional written, verbal, electronic, or physical act that a student or group of students exhibits toward another particular student(s) more than once and the behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student(s) and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student(s). The Board encourages the promotion of positive interpersonal relations between members of the school community. Harassment and/or aggressive behavior (including bullying/cyber-bullying) toward a student, whether by other students, staff, or third parties is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.

During the 1st semester of the 2024-2025 school year, two verified acts of harassment/bullying were addressed at Madison Middle School.

The administration and staff at Madison Middle School is committed to creating a safe learning environment for all students, therefore all allegations of harassment/bullying are investigated and addressed as appropriate.
